

Jungle Babies Child's Scarf and Hat

Supplies

- 1/2 yard [Jungle Babies Fleece](#)
- 1/2 yard [Jungle Babies Cotton](#)
- Cotton thread to match
- Sewing Machine

Scarf Instructions


1. Cut two 11 x 58 inch rectangles. One will be out of Jungle Babies Fleece, and the second out of Jungle Babies Cotton. **The cotton fabric will only measure to 44". You will need to cut a second rectangle of cotton at 11 x 15 inches and stitch the two pieces together using a 1/2" seam allowance.
2. Once you have cut both rectangles, pin them together around the edges with right sides together.
3. Stitch around the entire scarf using a 1/2" seam allowance and leaving a 3-4" unsewn gap at one end.
4. Trim the seam allowance to allow for better turning and trim each corner at an angle.
5. Turn the scarf right side out and press the edges flat.
6. Slipstitch the gap closed and enjoy in the cold weather!

Supplies

- 1/2 yard [Jungle Babies Fleece](#)
- Cotton thread to match
- Sewing Machine
- Hand sewing needle

Hat Instructions

1. Using pattern provided cut out two hat body pieces and two band pieces on the fold of the fabric. **Adjust the pattern based on the circumference of the child's head.
2. Sew the hat body pieces right sides together around the top and sides using a 1/2 inch seam allowance. Trim the seams to allow for easier turning.



3. Sew the band pieces right sides together at the side seams.



4. Turn the hat body right side out.
5. With right sides together, pin the band to the hat body and stitch around.



6. Fold the band in half where wrong sides are together and pin to inside of the hat body. Stitch in the ditch (stitch on seam) to finish the hat.



7. When done make sure the band is completely stitched to the seam.
8. Try on hat to make and enjoy!
