

Father's Day DIY Beer Coozie

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- ¼ yard of 100% cotton Tool Print 14550-LZ
- ¼ yard 100 % cotton coordinating fabric for backing
- ¼ yard of 45" batting (Suggested: [Traditional Poly Batting](#))
- 1 pack of ½ or ¾" iron-on Velcro
- Coordinating thread

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut a rectangle at 5" wide by 11" long out of both the Tool Print fabric and the coordinating fabric. Cut 2 rectangles at 5" wide by 11" long out of batting.
2. Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew the batting to the wrong side of each piece of fabric.
3. With right sides together and a ¼" seam allowance, sew the Tool Print fabric and coordinating fabric together leaving a 1" gap for flipping.
4. Trim the edges 1/8" from seam making sure to not cut into the seam.
5. Turn the coozie with right sides facing out.
6. Using a slipstitch, sew the hole closed. (**If desired, use a top stitch around the coozie for more stability or a decorative look)
7. Wrap your coozie around a can or bottle to check the fit and mark placement for Velcro. Following the directions on the packaging, cut down to size and apply the Velcro to the coozie in the marked area.
8. Once Velcro is secure the coozie is ready to enjoy!
