

# Infinity Scarf

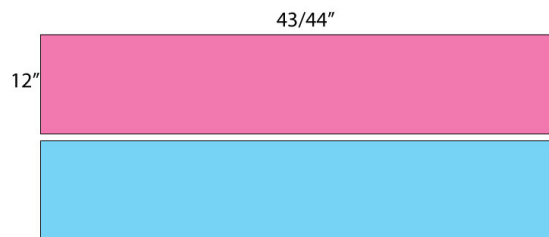

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

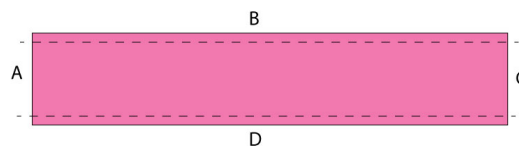
- ½ yard of Fabric Traditions' Lilah Collection floral cotton fabric
- ½ yard of Fabric Traditions' Lilah Collection plaid cotton fabric
- Sewing machine, Needle and coordinating thread
- Scissors or pinking shears

## DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut two rectangles of fabric the same size at 12" wide by 43"/44" long.

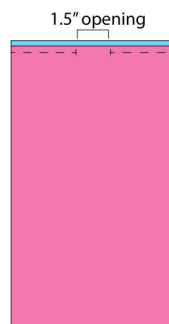


2. With right sides together, sew up the 2 long sides to create a tube.



3. Holding side A, pull through side C so the inside of the tube meets side C. The scarf should look as though it is folded in half matching side A to side C.

4. Sew both small sides together leaving a 1 ½" opening.



5. Turn the scarf right sides out and stitch the opening closed using an invisible stitch and your done!
