

Shamrock Throw Pillow

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/2 yard of Fabric Traditions' St. Patrick's Day cotton fabric for pillow case
- 1/4 yard of second Fabric Traditions' St. Patrick's Day cotton fabric or a solid fabric for shamrock
- Sewing machine, Needle and coordinating thread
- Scissors or pinking sheers

DIRECTIONS:

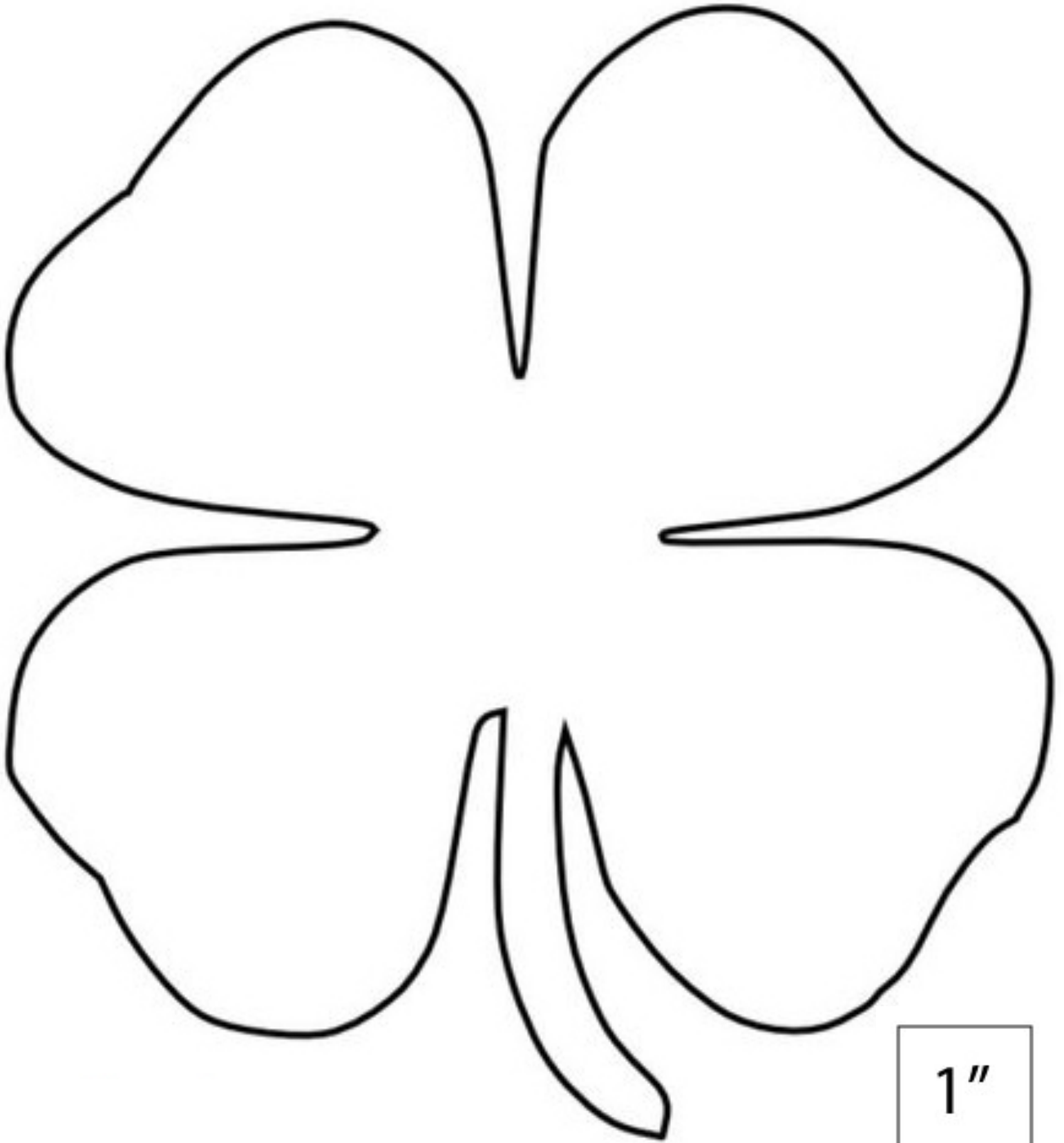
1. Cut one square and two rectangles from the pillow case fabric. One square at 16"x16", a rectangle at 16"x12", and another rectangle at 16"x10".
2. Cut out shamrock from the second fabric.
3. Center the shamrock (right side up) on the right side of the 16"x16" pillow case fabric piece and pin in place. Using a decorative top stitch (we used a zig zag stitch), stitch around the shamrock.
4. Fold 1/2" over on one of the long sides (16" side) for both small rectangles. Iron flat and top stitch.
5. Place the 16"x12" rectangle on top of the larger 16"x16" square with right sides together and pin in place. Place the 16"x10" rectangle on top of the 16"x16" square, overlapping the 16"x12" rectangle and pin down.
6. Stitch around the entire pillow case with a 1/8" – 1/4" seam allowance.
7. Turn right sides out and insert your pillow.

**Works for 16" square pillows. If using any other size pillow, alter sizes to fit.
