

Border It!

Adding a Border

Supplies & Tools:

- Creation Station 1 Yard Fabric Panel (Purchased from [JoAnn Fabrics](#))
- 1 Yard contrasting or matching solid cotton
- Pins, Scissors, Coordinating thread
- Sewing Machine

Adding the border

1. Cut two strips of fabric out of solid 45" long at 3" wide and two at 41" long at 3" wide.
2. With your panel facing up (right side up) place the two 45" long strips face down on each of the long sides of the panel. Pin and stitch down using a 1/2" stitch.
3. Line up the 41" long strips of fabric face down one each of the shorter sides of the panel that now has an added border on either side. Pin and stitch down using a 1/2" stitch.
4. Hem around the entire panel using folding the edges up 1/4" then again 1/2" to create a clean finish.
5. Optional Finish: Use "Hang It" directions for a bias tape finish.
