

Upcycled Jean Jacket

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Cotton Fabric - at least 1 yard
- Old Jean Jacket
- Tracing Paper or Parchment Paper
- Basic Sewing Supplies

DIRECTIONS:

- Find an area on your jacket that you wish to up-cycle. We chose the center back and cuffs.
- Take your tracing paper, or parchment paper, and create a pattern by tracing over the up-cycle area.
- Add a 1/4" seam allowance along the edges of your pattern.
- Cut out the pattern and place on the right side of your fabric, pin in place and cut out.
- Using an iron on low, turn under to the wrong side of the fabric using a 1/4" seam allowance and iron flat to conceal the raw edges.
- Place fabric in desired location on your jacket, pin in place. Stitch to jacket close to edges by hand or machine.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Approximate Crafting Time: 1-2 hours
